

RCC Poll Review: February 21, 2002

The poll game is afoot. The third week of February saw Ukraine's major polling agencies release the first nationwide public opinion poll results of voters, which include all competing 34 parties and blocs. Results for the leading parties and blocs are provided in the table below.

KIIS – *Kyiv International Institute of Sociology*. Poll conducted January 18 – 27. Respondents: 2273. Margin of error: at 50% – +/- 2.1%; at 4% – 0.8%. Results released on February 19, 2002.

Socis – Democratic Initiatives Foundation. Poll conducted February 1 – 7. Respondents: 1200. Margin of error: +/- 3%. Results released on February 21, 2002. Poll includes 7% of respondents who indicated that they will not vote.

UISS – Ukrainian Institute for Social Research & The Social Monitoring Center. Poll conducted February 7 – 9. Respondents: 2012. Margin of error: +/- 2.2%. Results released on February 19, 2002.

Razumkov Center – Ukrainian Center for Economic and Political Studies. Poll conducted January 30 – February 6. Respondents: 2012. No margin of error specified. Results released on February 13, 2002. Poll included 1 party and 1 bloc whose registrations were subsequently revoked by the *Central Electoral Committee*.
